ADMISSION TO PHYSIOTHERAPY AND CLINICAL NUTRITION.

B. ADMISSION TO DIPLOMA IN CLINICAL NUTRITION

Black Leather Shoes. (Open shoes/sandals and canvas shoes are not allowed in classes or in practical areas). Clean Gloves. Uniforms: Female and Male -One pair of uniforms. The total cost of uniforms is Tsh. 150,000 /= and will be paid to the college for college arrangements to maintain uniformity. Paid to the college through Number 0756 348348.

2. GENERAL REQUIREMENTS FOR ALL PROGRAMES

Upon arrival at MKURANGA COHAS Admission office, student should submit the following;

1. Admission letter to MKURANGA COHAS
2. Dully filled Medical Examination Form
3. Original Certificates of Secondary School Education
4. Birth certificate/Affidavit
5. Identity cards and Travel Passports for foreigners
6. Four (04) recent coloured passport-size photos
7. Bank Pay-in-Slip for Fees and other charges
8. Transcript /Recommendation Letter / Certificates of the Council (For upgrading NTA **LEVEL6**)

Warning: It is a criminal offence to submit false information/certificates/documents. Appropriate legal action will be taken in case of committing that offence

3. REQUIREMENTS FOR HOSTEL STUDENTS

- **Hostel is free**, but students are required to come with 1 blanket, 4 bed sheets, 1 pillow + 2 pillow cases, 1 mosquito net, 1 plastic bucket, Towels, Open shoes/sandals and canvas shoes for casual stay. All other outfits after classes **MUST** be of good manners.
- Students must pay for the Tzs 40,000/= to meet the cost of water that is paid for each Semester. All residents will share the hostel's electricity bill
- Electricity costs for hostel facilities will be borne by student themselves through their own arrangements. The average cost is 5000 per month.

Cafeteria and Canteen services

The cafeteria is open for students at prescribed times to cater for students' meal needs. A daily budget of Tzs 6,000/= is recommended for each student to accommodate meals,

5. REQUIREMENTS FOR PAYMENTS OF SCHOOL FEES AND OTHER CHARGES

- (i) College fees should be paid in full at the beginning of each academic year or in Four instalments for (Physiotherapy & Clinical Nutrition) as indicated in the next pages
- (ii) Meals deposits should be paid monthly into school canteen fund through number 0756- 348348
- (iii) Fees once paid will not be refunded if a student withdraws or leaves the College.
- (v) Payment by Cheque, International Money Orders (IMO) etc is accepted prior to clearance by the bank.

NOTE: Payment by M-Pesa, Tigo Pesa, and Airtel Money or any mobile number is **STRICTLY NOT ACCEPTED FOR COLLEGE FEES. All school Fees payment should be done through College Bank Accounts and not otherwise.**
