# **JOINING INSTRUCTIONS FOR ACADEMIC YEAR 2025/2026**

### ADMISSION TO DIPLOMA IN PHYSIOTHERAPY AND CLINICAL NUTRITION

Mkuranga College of Health and Allied Sciences is a private College fully registered by NACTE with **Reg No. NACTVET/1154** 

The college offer the following programs

- 1. Ordinary Diploma in Physiotherapy
- 2. Ordinary Diploma in Clinical Nutrition

Applicant will be required to pay application fee of Tsh 25,000/= (Twenty Five Thousand Only), and Tsh 20,000/= (Twenty Thousand Only) for application form.

## BASIC REQUIREMENTS FOR SPECIFIC COURSES

## 4. REQUIREMENTS FOR HOSTEL STUDENTS

- ➤ Hostel is free but student required to come with, 1 blanket, 4 bed sheets, 1 pillow + 2 pillow cases, 1 mosquito net, 1 plastic buckets, Towels, Open shoes/sandals and canvas shoes for casual stay. All other outfits after classes MUST be of good manner.
- > Students must pay for the Tzs 20,000/= to meet the cost of water that is paid for each Semester. The hostel electricity bill is shared by all residents.

#### Cafeteria and Canteen services

The College provides no food; however, the cafeteria is open for students at prescribed times to cater for students' meals need.

### 5. REQUIREMENTS FOR PAYMENTS OF SCHOOL FEES AND OTHER CHARGES

- (i) School fees and meal: Fees should be paid in full at the beginning of each academic year or in Four installments for (Physiotherapy, Clinical Nutrition & Pharmaceutical Sciences)
- (ii) Hostel charges should be paid in two installments at the beginning of each academic year.
- (iii) Fees once paid will not be refunded if a student withdraws or leaves the College.
