ADMISSION TO DIPLOMA IN PHYSIOTHERAPY AND CLINICAL NUTRITION

Mkuranga College of Health and Allied Sciences is a private College fully registered by NACTE with **Reg No. NACTVET/1154**

The college offer the following programs

1. Ordinary Diploma in Physiotherapy
2. Ordinary Diploma in Clinical Nutrition

Applicant will be required to pay application fee of Tsh 25,000/= (Twenty Five Thousand Only), and Tsh 20,000/= (Twenty Thousand Only) for application form.

BASIC REQUIREMENTS FOR SPECIFIC COURSES

All students Uniforms are available at the college for the cost that is indicated in your specific course. You are required to pay and obtain your uniforms at the College and not otherwise. This is for uniformity, standards and descent uniforms as required by the College.

Student Learning Kit with all necessary learning instruments shall be obtained from the college and not otherwise, as indicated in your specific course.

D. ADMISSION TO DIPLOMA IN PHARMACEUTICAL SCIENCES

Black Leather Shoes. (Open shoes/sandals and canvas shoes are not allowed in classes). Clean Gloves for personal use during clinical/practical sessions. Uniforms: Female and Male, One pair of uniforms and clinical coat for Tshs 120,000/=.

2. GENERAL REQUIREMENTS FOR ALL PROGRAMES

Upon arrival at MKURANGA COHAS Admission office, student should submit the following ;

1. Admission letter to MKURANGA COHAS
2. Dully filled Medical Examination Form
3. Original Certificates of Secondary School Education
4. Birth certificate/Affidavit
5. Identity cards and Travel Passports for foreigners
6. Four recent coloured passport size photos
7. Bank Pay-in-Slip for Fees and other charges
8. Transcript /Recommendation Letter / Certificates of the Council (For upgrading NTA **LEVEL6**)

Warning: It is criminal offence to submit false information/certificates/documents. Appropriate legal action will be taken in case of committing that offence

4. REQUIREMENTS FOR HOSTEL STUDENTS

- **Hostel is free** but student required to come with, 1 blanket, 4 bed sheets, 1 pillow + 2 pillow cases, 1 mosquito net, 1 plastic buckets, Towels, Open shoes/sandals and canvas shoes for casual stay. All other outfits after classes **MUST** be of good manner.
- Students must pay for the Tzs 20,000/= to meet the cost of water that is paid for each Semester. The hostel electricity bill is shared by all residents.

Cafeteria and Canteen services

The College provides no food; however, the cafeteria is open for students at prescribed times to cater for students' meals need.

5. REQUIREMENTS FOR PAYMENTS OF SCHOOL FEES AND OTHER CHARGES

- (i) School fees and meal: Fees should be paid in full at the beginning of each academic year or in Four installments for (Physiotherapy, Clinical Nutrition & Pharmaceutical Sciences)
- (ii) Hostel charges should be paid in two installments at the beginning of each academic year.
- (iii) Fees once paid will not be refunded if a student withdraws or leaves the College.

(All payments are non-refundable)

- (v) Payment by Cheque, International Money Orders (IMO) etc is accepted prior to clearance by the bank.

NOTE: Payment by M-Pesa, Tigo Pesa, and Airtel Money or any mobile number is **STRICTLY NOT ACCEPTED. WE DO NOT HAVE ANY AGENTS FOR FEES OR ANY OTHER CHARGE COLLECTION.**

- (vi) All payment should be done through College Bank Accounts and not otherwise.
